Other Degree Requirements

1. A minimum of 128 semester hours must be completed with a GPA of 2.00 or higher.
2. In addition to the requirements of this minor, students must complete all other requirements of the university as listed in the catalog.
3. All courses counted toward a Global Studies minor must be completed with grades of C- or higher & with a cumulative GPA of 2.00 or higher in those courses.
4. No more than 44 hours from any one department may be counted toward the 128 hours required for graduation.
5. No more than two courses (8 hrs) may be taken in any one discipline to fulfill the requirements for the concentration of the GLST minor. In addition, students may not apply more than two courses (8 hrs) from their primary major or from another minor to fulfill requirements for the GLST minor.
