by those who call themselves my friends.**

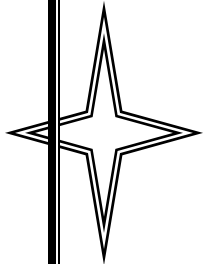
I have the right to leave any dating situation.
