Entrance Requirements

Foreign Language Requirement

Every student entering the university must:

Have satisfactory completed two high school years of one foreign language or the equivalent with a C average,

Demonstrate equivalent proficiency,

- Satisfy this requirement by completing one year of a foreign language at the college level.

Mathematics Requirement

Every student entering the university must:

- Have satisfactorily completed two years of college preparatory mathematics in high school (exclusive of computer science courses) or the equivalent with a C average,
- b. Demonstrate equivalent proficiency,
- Satisfy this requirement by completing an approved mathematics course at the college level.

Additional Admission Requirements for Some Programs

Your offer of admission to Pacific Lutheran University is to the general university curriculum only. The following programs have additional admission requirements.

SCHOOL OF BUSINESS

Requirements. To declare a major, you must successfully complete at least 32 semester hours (48 quarter hours) with a cumulative grade point average of 2.50 or above. You must also complete a series of prerequisite and lower division requirements prior to declaring.

Application and Deadlines. You may declare a business major as soon as the requirements are satisfied. To declare, contact the School of Business for the appropriate paperwork. Prior to declaration, you will be considered an intended business major.

SCHOOL OF EDUCATION & MOVEMENT STUDIES (SEMS) Requirements

- Official score report documenting passing scores on the Washington Skills Test - Basic (WEST-B).
- A cumulative grade point average of at least 2.50 with junior standing for elementary, and for secondary students.
- Completion of Psychology 101 and English 101 or equivalent courses with C or better grades.
- Application should include two SEMS admission recommendations. One must be an academic reference from a professor, preferably in
- Please provide official transcripts to the SEMS, in addition to those already submitted to the Office of Admission, for any credits earned at a community college or 4-year institution other than PLU.
- Complete a group interview. After your application is received and complete you will be sent an email with detailed instructions to call and reserve a spot once specific days and times have been scheduled.

Application and Deadlines. Application forms are available from the School of Education and Movement Studies Office or by visiting their website at www.plu.edu/education. Applications are accepted for Fall enrollment only and are due the first Friday of March. As part of the application process students are required to attend a group interview. Students are occasionally admitted to the SEMS provisionally on a case by case basis. Reassessment takes place throughout the program, but formal admission is granted at the completion of additional requirements identified during initial education methods courses.

SCHOOL OF NURSING

Requirements. The requirements listed below are minimum standards; satisfaction of minimum requirements does not imply nor guarantee admission to the program. To be considered for admission to the Basic nursing program, at minimum you must have:

- Completion (or pending completion) of at least 30 semester or 45 quarter credits.
- A minimum cumulative grade of 2.00 in each nursing prerequisite and co-requisite course.
- A minimum cumulative grade point average of 2.75 in the prerequisite courses.
- A cumulative grade point average of 3.00 or higher.
- No more than on repeat in the prerequisite and corequisite
- Civil, administrative and criminal clearance in all states as well as any other applicable territory or country.
- Completion of the university math entrance requirement (intermediate algebra), with a grade of "C" or higher.
- Physical health and emotional stability sufficient to meet the demands of nursing.
- College level fluency in speaking, reading, and writing English.

Application and Deadlines. Applications are available from the School of Nursing. To apply for Summer, Fall, or Spring terms of the following academic year, you should submit your application by February 1. Students who have applied by February 1 are notified in April. Students are admitted to the term of their choice whenever possible.

Applications received after February 1 will be reviewed monthly until all available positions are filled. If there are more applicants for the terms of the academic year than can be accommodated, qualified candidates are place on a wait list for admission if spaces become available.

SOCIAL WORK PROGRAM

Requirements. To be considered for admission to the Social Work Program, you must have:

- Completed 32 semester hours of prescribed course work with a minimum G.P.A. of 2.50.
- Submit a four-page personal statement
- Report work and volunteer history.
- Submit two letters of recommendation.
- Complete a Washington State Patrol Criminal Background
- Agree in writing to abide by the National Association of Social Workers' Code of Ethics.
- A personal interview may be requested by faculty.

Application and Deadlines. Applications are available from the Social Work Program or the PLU homepage. Applications will be accepted until all available positions are filled. Review for fall cohort begins April 18.
