RE: Conditional Loan Scholarships

A limited number of conditional loan scholarships may be available for the 2007-2008 alternative route program interns. The conditional scholarship is a loan that can be forgiven in exchange for teaching service in a designated shortage area. The legislature approves funding once a year and is estimated to announce the number of available funds, if any, and specific conditions in late May or early June.

To be considered for the conditional loan scholarship you must complete the following:

- Formal admission to PLU;
- Successful passage of the PRAXIS II in your endorsement area(s);
- Successful passage of the statewide basic skills exam (WEST-B); and
- Completed health form on file (this will be included in your admission packet).

To continue the process, complete and return the attached sheet with your Alternative Routes application. **By completing the conditional loan application and meeting the minimum requirements it does not guarantee that you will receive a conditional loan scholarship if available.**
