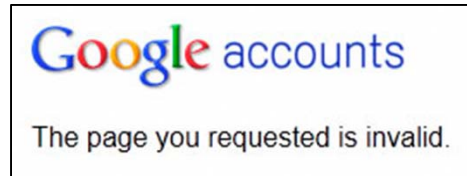




## Having trouble creating your Blogger account?

If this is your first time using Blogger with your PLU ePass domain account, you may see an error saying “**The page you requested is invalid.**” If so, follow these instructions to get your Blogger account set up.



**1. Sign in to PLU Google Apps**

You can sign into Google Apps by following the Gmail link on the PLU home page, or by browsing to <http://mail.g.plu.edu>

**2. Attempt to access Blogger**

At the top left corner of Gmail, you should see links to Mail, Calendar, Documents, Sites, and more. Click “**more**”. A drop-down menu will appear. Choose “**even more >>**”. You will see links to various Google Apps. The **Blogger** link is near the top of the right column. Click on the link.

**3. If you see the error... try again!**

Hit your browser’s **Back** button to go back to the previous page. Click on the “**Blogger**” link again, and you should now see the Blogger sign-in screen.

**4. Enter your username only**

The sign in form on the right asks for your “**Email**” and “**Password**”. Enter your “**ePass username**” plus “**@plu.edu**” for the Email, and **leave the Password field blank**. Then press the “**Sign In**” button.

**5. You’re in! Start setting up your blog**

If you see the **Sign up for Blogger** screen displayed to the right, you’re good to go! Follow the rest of the on-screen instructions, and you’ll be ready to start blogging in a few short minutes.
