

Faculty at PLU 2010-2011

Faculty Data

- As of Fall 2010, there are 271 full-time faculty (primarily instruction). 210 Tenure Track (139 Tenured)
- Seventy seven (77%) of all teaching faculty have doctoral degrees. Among all full-time faculty, 53% are female, 46% are male.
