The graduate fellowship program offers graduate students an opportunity to participate in academic and administrative activities that will enhance their graduate education experience, as well as provide financial assistance. In addition to this application and skills inventory, information in the applicant's admission file may be assessed. To be eligible for a graduate fellowship, an applicant must be: (a) admitted to a MAE Res Cert program at PLU, (b) maintain a minimum cumulative 3.0 graduate grade point average, and (c) be enrolled full-time [4 credits or more except J-term] during the semester/term of the fellowship.

A limited number of fellowships are available during academic year. Full awards are very rare. In general, fellowship awards are for interactions and opportunities involving time commitments between five and ten hours per week. Criteria for awarding fellowships may include any combination of the following: (a) skills and abilities, (b) academic merit, (c) potential for success, and (d) contribution to the mission of the graduate program and university. Fellowships may be considered taxable income.

HOW TO APPLY: Submit both pages of this form along with a current resume to the address listed at the bottom of the page by the February 1st deadline.

February 1st is the priority application date for fellowship consideration for the coming academic year. Applications received after the priority date will be reviewed as funds are available.

Total amount of fellowship and scholarship financial aid <u>cannot exceed</u> a student's total tuition cost for the period awarded.
