

2014 Master of Arts in Social Sciences MARRIAGE AND FAMILY THERAPY

Classes begin Fall 2014

- The 2014-2016, 24-month Marriage and Family Program is 47 continuous semester hours from fall of 2014 to summer or fall of 2016 with a total program cost of \$48,175 or \$1,025 per semester hour.
- Students may choose to do a five practica/theory sequence for an additional 2 semester units. The program length increases to 27-months, with 49 continuous semester hours for a total program cost of \$50,225.
- ♦ Tuition is based on a cohort model. Students must complete the program with their cohort to remain eligible for cohort pricing.
- ♦ Additional fees may include: Books, Graduation Fee, Thesis Binding, etc.
- Federal financial aid is available, and students may apply for PLU Graduate scholarship and fellowships.

Charles D. York and Cheryl L. Storm Graduate Scholarships

Each year Pacific Lutheran University awards two new students in the MFT program \$10,000 per year scholarships. These graduate scholarships are named for individuals who have been influential in the founding and shaping of the MFT program at PLU.

Fellowships

The MFT program also offers a limited number of one-year fellowships to incoming students. The fellowships involve working 5-10 hours per week in the clinic office, assisting the program coordinator or assisting faculty with research. Fellowship applications are mailed with letters of acceptance.

SCHEDULING OPTIONS

Students work with program Advisors to complete the Student/Program agreement. Students agree to complete their practica/theory sequence in four or five semesters and may provide a preference of either starting in the summer or the fall of year two. Any changes to this scheduling are made in consultation with your advisor.
