## Laundry/Clothing Care

- □ Laundry basket or bag
- Iron (community ironing boards are available)\*\*

## Items to Consider

- □ Sewing kit
- □ First aid supplies
- Headache/cold/flu medicine
- □ Alarm clock
- □ Mug, glass, plate, knife, spoon, fork, pan/cookware
- $\hfill\square$  Battery-powered flashlight
- Earthquake kit (battery-powered flashlight and radio, batteries, bottled water, supply of prescribed medications, first aid items)
- The University supplies vacuum cleaners light bulbs and toilet paper (except in singles with baths and in South Hall).
