1. Pre-requisite: SOCI 101
2. **200-level electives** include Social Problems (240) and Social Stratification (296). SOCI 296 has a pre-req of SOCI 101 or SOCI 240.
3. **300-level electives** include Delinquency & Juvenile Justice (326), The Family (330), Race & Ethnicity (332), Deviance (336), Special Topics (387), and Sociology of Religion (391). All have a pre-req of SOCI 101.
4. **400-level electives** include Crime & Society (413), Gender & Sexuality (440), Independent Study (491), and Internship (495). All have a pre-req of SOCI 101 (or WMGS 201 for SOCI 440).
5. Pre-req of SOCI 101, SOCI 232, 8 additional hours of Sociology, and senior status. Class is offered ONLY in Fall semester.
6. Pre-req of SOCI 496, SOCI 232, STAT 233, and senior status. Class is offered ONLY in Spring semester.

\* Students with marginal grades in SOCI 101 and students who have not taken sociology classes for several years should enroll in 200-level courses before trying 300 or 400-level classes.
