OFFICIAL FULL WITHDRAWAL FROM PLU

Fall/ Spring Tuition

- ◆ 100% tuition refund prior to the first day of class
- ◆ Refunds prorated on daily basis beginning the first day of class until 60% of semester has elapsed.
- ◆ Once 60% of semester has elapsed, no tuition refund.

Summer/J-Term Tuition

- ◆ 100% refund up to the last day to drop without a fee for term. (Go to www.plu.edu/~regi/class-schedules)
- ◆ No refund after the last day to add/drop without a fee for term. (Go to www.plu.edu/~regi/class-schedules)

Summer/Fall/J-Term/Spring Course Fees

- ◆ 100% refund prior to the first day of class.
- ◆ No refunds beginning the first day of class.

Summer/Fall/J-Term/Spring Housing and Meal Plans

- ◆ Housing refunds prorated on a daily basis.
- ◆ Meal Plan refunds prorated on a weekly basis.

LATE REGISTRATION FEE

Students adding or withdrawing from a course(s) after the last day to add/drop date during a semester, is assessed an administrative handling fee per transaction. \$ 100

PLU STUDENT HEALTH INSURANCE

Waive-out required each academic year you attend.**
