Other Degree Requirements

1. A minimum of 128 semester hours must be completed with a GPA of 2.00 or higher.
2. In addition to the requirements of this major, students must complete all other requirements of the University as listed in the catalog.
3. All courses counted toward a Global Studies major must be completed with grades of C- or higher & with a cumulative GPA of 2.00 or higher in those courses.
4. The BA in Global Studies requires completion of Option I of the College of Arts & Sciences Requirement via Option 1.
5. No more than 44 hours from any one department may be counted toward the 128 hours required for graduation.
6. At least 8 semester hours for the major must be taken in residence at PLU.
7. No more than two courses (8 hrs) may be taken in any one discipline to fulfill the requirements for the concentration of the GLST major. In addition, students may not apply more than two courses (8 hrs) from their primary major or from another minor to fulfill requirements for the GLST major.
