

## Recommended Course Sequencing for Sociology Majors

1. SOCI 101/190 is a prerequisite for SOCI 232, STAT 233, and most 300- and 400-level courses.
2. SOCI 330 and 336 are research-intensive courses. In addition to the prerequisite of SOCI 101/190, we expect that students enrolled in SOCI 330/336 have completed or are in the process of completing SOCI 232 or STAT 233.
3. SOCI 496 prerequisites: SOCI 101/190, 232, 330/336, and STAT 233; senior status; and declared major or minor.
4. SOCI 499 prerequisites: SOCI 496.
