#### **HOW TO SIGN UP FOR NSR**



## Student employment

As soon as you are registered for fall classes, you can apply for on-campus jobs! Check listings for on-campus and off-campus jobs on the Opportunities Board at plu.edu/studentemployment.

#### **WORK STUDY FAQS**

- Q Where on campus can I use my work study?
- **A** All on-campus jobs are work study eligible. There are offcampus options too.
- Q I don't have work study. Can I still work on campus?
- A Absolutely! On-campus jobs are open to all students.
- Q If I don't work my first semester or even first year, will I lose my work study?
- A You won't. You must, however, complete the FAFSA every year to be considered for work study eligibility.



## Office of Accessibility and Accommodation

The Office of Accessibility and Accommodation (OAA)

is dedicated to ensuring equitable access and inclusion for all PLU students and serves students with either temporary or permanent physical, health, learning, sensory or psychological disabilities. Reasonable accommodations and services are provided at no cost to the student on a caseby-case basis.





Mental health care has long been a topic of importance at PLU. In early 2020, PLU was one of the first universities to adopt 24/7 telehealth and virtual medical and mental health services, known as Lute Telehealth. The program ensures students have access to many different providers and offers mental health resources and medical resources to students at any time, whether they are on campus or in another location.
