LUTE LIFE DAYS


Lute Life Days are personalized program days that let you fully experience what it's like to be a PLU student.



OUR NEARBY FAVORITES

DOWNTOWN TACOMA

DIRECTIONS TO CAMPUS

From I-5

- Take Exit 127 off Interstate 5 and head east on Highway 512.
- Continue on 512 for approximately 2 miles.
- Take the WA-7/Pacific Avenue exit.
- Turn right on Pacific Avenue South.
- Turn right on Garfield Street.
- PLU is located at the intersection of Garfield Street South and Park Avenue South.
