International students who do not meet the English proficiency requirement for admission are encouraged to join the University community through the International Pathway Program (IPP). The IPP is administered by PLU on its campus. PLU Undergraduate IPP enables 1st year international students to reach sophomore status after one year regardless of their English proficiency level.

2. Send official transcripts translated to English from all schools you've attended (starting from upper secondary and any schools you are currently attending)
3. Submit a TOEFL, IELTS or other English proficiency score. A financial guarantee (bank statement), a copy of passport biographical information page, and enrollment deposit will be required prior to issuing a visa application support document (I-20).
