



Pierce to PLU

Bachelor of Arts in Education transfer degree plan

PLU accepts direct transfer degrees from Pierce College (AA-DTA). If you earn a DTA from Pierce, you will enter PLU with automatic junior standing and given credit for having satisfied all core and general education requirements, except for four semester hours in religion and four semester hours in diversity, both of which must be taken at PLU.

At Pierce:

If you plan to major in **Education** at PLU, your Pierce DTA must include the following courses:

MUSC 205: Music for Young Children PSYC&100: General Psychology MATH&131: Math for Elem. Educ. I
 ART 215: Art for Young Children ENGL&101: English Composition I MATH&132: Math for Elem. Educ. II
 BIOL&100, &160, or other approved life science OCEA&101 or other approved physical science

In order to be eligible for PLU's Education Program, you must have a 'C' grade or better in PSYC&100, ENGL&101, and MATH&131; have a 2.75+ cumulative GPA; and pass the WEST-B with a 240+ score or have equivalent SAT/ACT test scores.
