

Memorandum of Understanding on Conditional Admission between Green River College and Pacific Lutheran University (PLU)

In order to benefit both Pacific Lutheran University (PLU) and Green River College (the Parties) in the recruitment of international students, and to assist international students in their educational planning and in the completion of a baccalaureate degree, PLU and Green River College wish to enter into an agreement of assured admission.

Under this agreement, PLU will admit qualified current and prospective Green River College students into the University. PLU agrees to define qualified Green River College students as those who have:

- Completed or will complete a Washington state transferrable Associate's degree;
- Achieved a minimum cumulative college-level GPA of 2.75 in all transferable academic coursework (at all colleges attended);
- Evidence of English proficiency: Completion of Green River College's English 101 and 102 with a grade B or better or iBT TOEFL 79 or IELTS 6.5 or PTE 56;
- Submit a complete transfer application by the applicable admission deadline.

This agreement *does not* guarantee admission to a degree program within the university. Additional program or university requirements must be met in order to complete a baccalaureate degree.

PLU and Green River College agree that:

- Green River College will inform prospective international students of this 2 + 2 partnership;
- Both institutions will advertise this 2 + 2 partnership on their website;
- Green River College will provide PLU with the contact information of students who choose this guaranteed conditional admission;
- Green River College will mail a letter of PLU guaranteed conditional admission to all international students who select this program.
