Bachelor of Arts in Education (BAE) transfer guide

A completed **Associate of Arts (AA-DTA)** degree (96 credits) from **North Seattle College** will satisfy 12 of 14 general education requirements (the remaining 2 must be met at PLU) and will guarantee junior standing upon transfer to Pacific Lutheran University.

At North Seattle:

The **AA-DTA** degree must include the following coursework with a cumulative GPA of 2.75* or better:

ENGL&101 English Composition I MATH&131 Math for Elementary Educ I 1 life science course

PSYC&100 General Psychology MATH&132 Math for Elementary Educ II 1 physical science course

*To be eligible to apply to PLU's Education Program, a grade of C or better is required in ENGL&101, PSYC&100, and MATH&132.
