## Bachelor of Science (BS) in Psychology transfer guide

A completed **Associate of Arts (AA-DTA)** degree (96 credits) from **Olympic College** will satisfy 12 of 14 general education requirements (the remaining 2 must be met at PLU) and will guarantee junior standing upon transfer to Pacific Lutheran University.

## **At Olympic:**

The AA-DTA\* degree must include the following coursework with a grade of C- or better:

PSYC&100 General Psychology MATH&141 Precalculus I

PSYC&200 Lifespan Psychology **or** PSYC&220 Abnormal Psychology MATH&142 Precalculus II

2 Biology courses:

BIOL&100, &160, &211, &212, &213, &241, &242, &260

1 additional math or science 100+ course: ASTR&, BIOL&, CHEM&, ENVS&, GEOL&, MATH&, OCEA&, PHYS&

\*A completed Associate in Pre-Nursing DTA with the above courses will also prepare for the BS in Psychology program.
