Bachelor of Arts (BA) in Social Work transfer guide

A completed **Associate of Arts (AA-DTA)** degree (96 credits) from **Seattle Central College** will satisfy 12 of 14 general education requirements (the remaining 2 must be met at PLU) and will guarantee junior standing upon transfer to Pacific Lutheran University.

At Seattle Central:

The **AA-DTA*** degree must include the following coursework with a grade of C or better and a cumulative GPA of 2.75 or better to be eligible to apply to PLU's Social Work program:

ANTH&206 Cultural Anthropology** ENGL&101 English Composition I SOC&101 Introduction to Sociology
 BIOL&100, &160, **or** &241** PSYC&100 General Psychology

*A completed **Associate in Pre-Nursing DTA** with the above courses will also prepare a student for the **BA in Social Work** program.

**ANTH&206 and BIOL&100/160/241 requirements can be completed during the first term at PLU after transfer.
