Black Diamond Adventure Camps Mission Statement:

Black Diamond Camps is located 35 miles south of Seattle, WA and nestled among the pine trees in the lovely king county. The camp covers roughly 160 acres and was founded in 1973, with a transition in ownership in 2016, Black Diamond can accommodate anywhere from 550-600 guests at one time.

Our summer staff program is designed to help develop Christian leadership principles and discipleship in a practical work setting during the summer. It is our desire that every staff member experience growth in their relationship with God, find new ways to minister to people through serving, and enjoy many of the exciting events and activities that we have out here in the summer. Our Open Positions:

- **Summer Counselors:**
We are looking for counselors to work with all four different programs: Group Camp, Day Camp, Sports Camp, and Summer Camp. As a counselor you will be trained in all four programs and throughout the summer you will rotate between them.
- **Rainier Campus Staff:**
Rainier Staff is a team assigned to host and facilitate activities for our retreat groups up at Black Diamond Camps at Rainier. Duties include, but not limited to, belaying rock climbers, leading mountain biking, housekeeping tasks, preparing and cleaning group meals, and facilitating group games. This group of individuals must have the heart to serve in a more behind-the-scenes environment and live in a more remote location (still with access to wifi & cell service though). Our Rainier Campus is located in the woods outside Mount Rainier National Park.
- **Medical Staff:**
Medical staff address camp-wide health needs for all guests and campers, specifically within Group Camp, from a ministry-driven and servant-minded perspective. Employees must be organized, detailed and assertive self-motivators confident in their medical skills and ability to stay calm and in control in all situations.
- **Food Services:**
Employees work in all phases of cafeteria food service production including cooking, cleaning, hosting, dishwashing and service. They help with both indoor and outdoor meals and contribute to a pleasing environment and healthy food experience. As with all positions, food service staff are asked to help with any responsibility to help camp function smoothly (i.e. cleaning rooms, work projects, etc.).
