Winterfest is a Parkland-Spanaway community event that inspires hope and dignity by connecting low-income families with gifts and resources during the holiday season. This year's event will take place on Saturday, December 16 from 10am-1pm on Saturday, December 16. Winterfest has been a staple in the Parkland-Spanaway community for the past 30 years, connecting some of the most vulnerable families with gifts, household supplies and long-term community resources.

We invite 300 families, deliberately selected by counselors and family support workers in local schools, to participate in a fun day of festivities, gifts, a holiday fair, gifts, and much more. Each family gets to place a customized order for a \$40 holiday gift and jacket for each child in their care. On the day of the event, families get to enjoy food and drinks, a photo with Santa, professional family portraits, and holiday crafts and games.

Many of the gifts and program supplies are donated by individuals, businesses and faith-based organizations in our community. We also rely on financial donations from local businesses, foundations and community groups to ensure that all 300 families (approximately 750 kids) receive a customized gift, jacket and holiday experience.
