AWARD

- **One award of \$1,701.**
- The PLU Business Network Scholarship award is to be used for school-related expenses (such as tuition, books and practicum experience). For the student receiving financial aid, the award will replace the equivalent amount of loan or work study funding.

CRITERIA

- Candidates must be a MBA, MSF or MSMA student or declared business major with an anticipated graduation date during the 2019-2020 academic year.
- Candidates must have a minimum cumulative GPA of 3.00.
- Candidates for the PLU Business Network Scholarship will be evaluated on demonstrated leadership abilities, communication skills, potential for success, commitment to business ethics and community service.

EXPLANATION/PHILOSOPHY

This scholarship is sponsored by PLU Business Network, the alumni organization of the School of Business at Pacific Lutheran University. PLU Business Network is dedicated to strengthening the ties between alumni, current students and the business community.

The PLU Business Network Board of Directors recognizes that academic achievement is only one of many criteria for success in the business world. 4. Please share any other information that you feel is important.
