

Northwest Association of Environmental Professionals DEI Scholarship Program



Each year, NWAEP (the Northwest Association of Environmental Professionals) awards a scholarship that aims to support the professional development of students who are underrepresented in environmental careers (i.e. BIPOC, women, minorities).

The DEI Scholarship covers one year of NWAEP membership fees *plus* participation expenses (up to \$2,000 for registration, travel, room and board) so recipients may attend the National Association of Environmental Professionals' annual conference. Both are great networking opportunities for anyone soon to be entering the job market. Scholarship recipient(s) will be introduced to people who will be their future colleagues — and they'll be “in the know” about career paths, jobs, and companies.

DETAILS

Requirements:

- Applicants must be enrolled in or have been accepted into a degree program in Oregon or Washington state, graduate or undergraduate
- Applicants' major field of study must be relevant to STEM and/or environmental science
- Applications need to be completed and submitted by the deadline, **January 8, 2024**

Expectations:

- Recipient(s) should commit to attending the 2024 NAEP Annual Conference, held May 5–8, 2024, in Minneapolis
- Recipient(s) will provide updates describing their use of scholarship funds and/or their conference experience

Bonus:

- Scholarship recipient(s) will be given the opportunity to partner with a professional in their field to prepare a poster to present at the NAEP Conference



Applications are due by **January 8, 2024.**
