WHAT?!

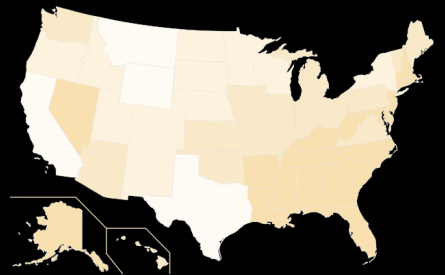


STATE AUTHORIZATION:

is the act of obtaining approval before enrolling students, advertising, teaching, etc. in other states.

PLU has received **APPROVAL or EXEMPTION** for **ONLINE** learning in **49** states, including Washington D.C.*

*Not currently accepting online students from MA



National Council for State Authorization Reciprocity Agreements

PLU joined NC-SARA in 2016

- Allows PLU to enroll online students from any NC-SARA state
- Provides common standards for “presence” in member states

PRESENCE

is defined differently by each (non-SARA) state & we must refer to those policies before pursuing out-of-state faculty or any physical activities in the state (marketing, locations, etc)
