Post-Masters to Doctor of Nursing Practice

Non-ARNP-Prepared



- The 2017-2019, 24-month post-master's to DNP for non-ARNP-prepared nurses is 54 continuous semester hours from summer of 2017 to spring of 2019, with a total program cost of \$60,210 or \$1,115 per semester hour.
- Tuition is based on a cohort model. Students must complete the program with their cohort to remain eligible for cohort pricing.
- Additional fees may include: Books, Graduation Fee, etc.

Total: \$60,210

Additional coursework may be required based on coursework analysis (must meet the AACN DNP Essentials competencies)
