# Program Cost Sheet Post-Masters to Doctor of Nursing Practice ARNP-Prepared



- The 2016 -2018, 24-month post-master's to DNP for ARNP-prepared nurses is 29 continuous semester hours from summer of 2016 to spring of 2018, with a total program cost of \$32,335 or \$1,115 per semester hour.
- Tuition is based on a cohort model. Students must complete the program with their cohort to remain eligible for cohort pricing.
- Additional fees may include: Books, Graduation Fee, etc.
