

# Program Cost Sheet

## BSN to Doctor of Nursing Practice, FNP Part-Time



- The 2019-2023, 48-month, part-time BSN to DNP is 80 continuous semester hours from summer of 2019 to spring of 2023, with a **total tuition cost of \$90,000** or \$1,125 per semesterhour.
- Tuition is based on a cohort model. Students must complete the program with their cohort to remain eligible for cohort pricing.
- Additional fees may include: Books, Graduation Fee, etc.
- Federal financial aid is available, and students may apply for PLU Graduate scholarship and fellowships. The FAFSA application becomes available for the following academic year on January 1<sup>st</sup>.
