- The 2019-2022 post-master's to DNP Family Nurse Practitioner (for non-ARNP-prepared nurses) is 69 semester hours from fall 2019 to spring 2022, with a total tuition cost of \$77,625 or \$1,125 per credit hour. Actual coursework and length of study depend on gap analysis for transfer-in credits.
