Post-Masters to Doctor of Nursing Practice

ARNP-Prepared



- The 2019-2021 post-master's to DNP for ARNP-prepared nurses is 29 continuous semester hours from summer of 2019 to spring of 2021, with a **total tuition cost of \$32,625** or \$1,125 per semester hour. Actual coursework and length of study depend on gap analysis for transfer-in credits.
- Tuition is based on a cohort model. Students must complete the program with their cohort to remain eligible for cohort pricing.
- Additional fees may include: Books, Graduation Fee, etc.
- Nursing Program Fee: \$4,266 (Subject to change)

Total Tuition: \$32,625

Additional coursework may be required based on coursework analysis (must meet the AACN DNP Essentials competencies)
