

Program Cost Sheet

Post-Graduate Certificate for Family Nurse Practitioner



- The 2018-2019, 18-month Family Nurse Practitioner Certificate is 33 continuous semester hours from summer of 2018 to Fall of 2019, with a **total tuition cost of \$37,125** or \$1,125 per semester hour.
- Tuition is based on a cohort model. Students must complete the program with their cohort to remain eligible for cohort pricing.
- Additional fees may include: Books, Graduation Fee, etc.
