

Program Cost Sheet

Post-Graduate Certificate for Family Nurse Practitioner



- The 2020-2022, 28-month Family Nurse Practitioner Certificate is 40 continuous semester hours from spring of 2020 to spring of 2022, with a **total tuition cost of \$45,000** or \$1,125 per semester hour.
- Tuition is based on a cohort model. Students must complete the program with their cohort to remain eligible for cohort pricing.
- Additional fees may include: Books, Graduation Fee, etc.
- Nursing Program Fee: \$4,266 (Subject to change)

Total Tuition: \$45,000

Additional coursework may be required based on coursework analysis (must meet the AACN DNP Essentials competencies)
