The 2020-2023, 36-month post-master's to DNP Family Nurse Practitioner (for non-ARNP-prepared nurses) is 80 continuous semester hours from summer of 2020 to spring of 2023, **with a total tuition cost of \$91,840** or \$1,148 per semester hour. Actual coursework and length of study depend on gap analysis for transfer-in credits.

Tuition is based on a cohort model. Students must complete the program with their cohort to remain eligible for cohort pricing.

Additional fees include: technology fee (\$250/year), wellness fee (\$100/year), a one-time matriculation fee (\$200), books and materials for coursework.
