## Post-Masters to Doctor of Nursing Practice, FNP

The 2021-2024, 36-month post-master's to DNP Family Nurse Practitioner (for non-ARNP-prepared nurses) is 80 continuous semester hours from summer of 2021 to spring of 2024, **with a total tuition cost of \$91,840** or \$1,148 per semester hour. Actual coursework and length of study depend on gap analysis for transfer-in credits.

Tuition is based on a cohort model. Students must complete the program with their cohort to remain eligible for cohort pricing.

Additional fees include: technology fee (\$250/year), wellness fee (\$100/year), a one-time matriculation fee (\$200), books and materials for coursework.

**Total Tuition: \$91,840**

**Nursing Program Fee: \$5,688** (*Subject to change*)
