The post-master's to DNP Family Nurse Practitioner (for non-ARNP-prepared nurses) requires 80 semester credits for completion **with a total tuition cost of \$92,720**. Actual coursework and length of study depend on gap analysis for transfer-in credits.

Tuition is based on a cohort model. Students must complete the program with their cohort to remain eligible for cohort pricing.

**Total Tuition: \$92,720** (\$1,159 per semester credit)

**Nursing Program Fee: \$5,868** (*Subject to change*)

Additional fees include: technology fee (\$250/year), wellness fee (\$100/year), a one-time matriculation fee (\$200), background check (\$70), books and materials for coursework, uniform cost (\$200), equipment (\$100), laptop (not Chrome book).
