- In comparison to the last online class I took, Professor Rogers does a much better job of getting the students to engage seriously with each other, though I suppose that there are numerous factors for this, such as subject (English instead of Music) and level (300 instead of 100). Still, I think that he did a good job of encouraging academic dialogue. The lesson activities intimately engaged the students with the material covered from the readings, thus demanding application of knowledge.

- The instructor effectively made tons of videos to provide fantastic feedback and guidance throughout the class entirely. In addition the use of visual aids proved to be quite helpful when conveying certain abstract or difficult to understand concepts.
- The website is very well structured (though the pocket lessons make a given lesson much longer than it appears from the surface), and it is easy to navigate and find out what has to be done. The syllabus is particularly helpful, since it has a checklist of all the assignments. He often delivers content in at least two different ways, such as paraphrasing readings or posting YouTube videos that often have a written version in the lesson.
- By providing several medias of communication: videos, written lessons, links to articles, etc.
- He posted a lot of videos offering instruction that made him very clear in what he expected of us.
- Giving videos about comments and reviews is a very good way. Plus, the professor almost re-organize our idea after every small assignment. That can be good for students to create writing structure.

- Material was presented in multiple media, such as text, videos, images, and diagrams. Professor Rogers was very accommodating with allowing me to continue posting assignments as I completed them, and responding promptly to emailed concerns.
- Provided ample feedback to each assignment that was specific to the student's response.
- He responded to emails quickly and was always available.
- He pointed out every small mistakes and major concerns in my works. This was great commitment as I think there were so many comments. It made me wonder how much time he has to spend in order to fully understand and make comments for students.
