- Market and advertise for created programs, and develop strategies to increase QT-related program visibility, accessibility, and recruitment.
- Add promotional and educational content to the appropriate social media venues.
- Collaborate with PRISM, ASPLU, Reike Scholars and other related groups to ensure quality programming. CGE and Diversity Center Tasks
- Participate in regular staff meetings and trainings.
- Perform additional duties as assigned.
