



PLU COVID-19 Vaccination Policy for Faculty and Staff *Revised January 2022*

At PLU, fully-vaccinated is now defined as vaccinated with a booster. All students, faculty, and staff are required to get a booster shot by Monday, February 7, 2022, or within 14 days of their eligibility. Employees must upload proof of COVID-19 vaccination (and booster if eligible) in the [Etrieve portal](#).

Exemptions

Faculty and staff with documented medical or religious exemptions will be accommodated and not required to receive the vaccine. Medical exemptions are based on CDC contraindications for the vaccine and must be discussed with and signed off by a healthcare provider.

If you feel that you are ineligible for the booster because of severe side effects from the initial series, please contact your healthcare provider to request a medical exemption.

Given unknown vaccine requirements of foreign jurisdictions, exemptions may preclude participation in international Study Away programs.

Questions concerning exemptions should be directed to Human Resources.

Exempt and partially vaccinated employees

Employees that are exempt and those employees waiting to complete their vaccine series must comply with additional mitigation protocols, including:

- Weekly testing
- Wearing a mask
- Following the CDC and Washington State recommendations to quarantine if exposed to a positive case

The university will continue to review CDC and Washington State guidance to inform policy and procedures.

Employees with COVID-19-like symptoms

Any employee who develops illness symptoms consistent with COVID-19, regardless of vaccination status should contact their healthcare provider for evaluation and possible COVID-19 testing.
