- O Annotations and responses will be assessed with a "+" (reflecting a high degree of thoughtfulness/engagement with the text and its context; equates to 100%), a "√" (demonstrating a satisfactory level of thoughtfulness/engagement; equates to 85%), or a "-" (demonstrating a minimal degree of thoughtfulness/engagement; equates to 70%).
