Applications for the 2018-19 Scandinavian Cultural Center Endowed Scholarships and Awards are due on Saturday, April 7. Complete applications consist of the application form (found at <https://forms.plu.edu/2134>) and include any additional documents stipulated for the individual scholarships/awards below. Submit your completed application form with all required documents via the website. Only complete applications will be considered. Neil Anderson Merit Scholarship (\$4,000)

Eligibility:

- PLU Nordic Studies, Scandinavian Area Studies or Norwegian major
- Full-time student
- Overall GPA minimum 3.3
- Nordic Studies major GPA minimum 3.5
- Junior or senior standing as of Fall 2017
- Preference will be given to students who have completed 2 college-level courses beyond first-year Scandinavian language (or 1 course completed, 1 in progress)
- Students already receiving full-tuition scholarships are not eligible for the Neil Anderson Merit Scholarship

A complete application will consist of:

- Online application form (<https://forms.plu.edu/2134>), including essay and unofficial transcript.
Essay: How is literature or folklore part of your understanding of your world? Discuss a specific text that provided you with a new perspective of Nordic culture. (500-750 words)

Susan E. Young Study in Scandinavia Award (\$4,000)

Eligibility:

- Full-time student at PLU; preference will be given to majors/minors in Nordic Studies, Scandinavian Area Studies, and Norwegian.
- Overall GPA minimum: 3.0
- Major GPA minimum: 3.3
- Sophomore, junior, or senior standing as of Fall 2018
- Study at PLU-approved summer, J-term, semester, or year program
- Funds must be used for the stated study abroad purpose

A complete application will consist of:

- Online application form (<https://forms.plu.edu/2134>), including a statement of what the award will be used for, detailed cost and budget outline, and unofficial transcript

Faculty-Student Research (\$1,200)

Eligibility:

- Full-time student at PLU; preference will be given to majors/minors in Nordic Studies, Scandinavian Area Studies, and Norwegian.
- Overall GPA minimum: 3.0
- Major GPA minimum: 3.3
- Junior or senior standing as of Fall 2018
- Funds must be used for the stated research purpose

A complete application will consist of:

- Online application form (<https://forms.plu.edu/2134>), including project description, detailed cost budget outline, and unofficial transcript
- A brief statement of support from the faculty member supervising research

Study Away Award (\$2,000)

Eligibility:

- Full-time student at PLU; preference will be given to majors/minors in Nordic Studies, Scandinavian Area Studies, and Norwegian.
- Overall GPA minimum: 3.0
- Major GPA minimum: 3.3
- Sophomore, junior, or senior standing as of Fall 2018
- Study at PLU-approved summer, J-term, semester, or year program in Scandinavia
- Funds must be used for the stated study abroad purpose
