

Program Cost Sheet

Master of Arts in Education with Secondary Certification



The 2017-2018, 14-month MAE Program with Secondary Certification is 36 continuous semester hours from summer of 2017 to summer 2018.

The option to complete a thesis for pass/fail credit will add 4 additional credits to the degree at a cost of \$875 per credit.

Tuition is based on a cohort model. Students must complete the program with their cohort to remain eligible for cohort pricing.

Additional fees may include: Certification fee, fingerprinting, graduation fee, testing, etc.

Total program cost: \$31,500 or \$875 per semester hour
