

The 2018 – 2019, 12-month MAE program with Elementary Certification is 38 continuous semester hours from summer of 2018 to summer 2019.

The option to complete a thesis for pass/fail credit will add 4 additional credits to the degree at a cost of \$875 per credit.

Tuition is based on a cohort model. Students must complete the program with their cohort to remain eligible for cohort pricing. Additional fees may include: Certification fee, fingerprinting, graduation fee, testing, etc.

Total program cost: \$33,250 or \$875 per semester hour.
