

The 2019 - 2023, Alternative Routes MAE with Secondary and Special Education Certification

- The certificate portion of the MAE-ARC is 19 semester hours from summer 2019 to spring 2020, plus 18 credits of Continuing Education coursework for the special education endorsement.
- After completion of the certificate portion of the MAE-ARC, students have 3 years to complete the remaining 17 credits required of the MAE degree.

The option to complete a thesis for pass/fail credit will add 4 additional credits to the degree at a cost of \$825 per credit.

Tuition is based on a cohort model. Students must complete the program with their cohort to remain eligible for cohort pricing. Tuition for 500 Level coursework is \$850 per credit. Tuition for 900 Level coursework is \$250 per credit.

Additional fees may include: Certification fee, fingerprinting, graduation fee, placement file, etc.

Total cost for certification program with special education coursework (37 credits): \$20,650

Total program cost w/MAE (54 credits): \$35,100
