### Alt. Route to Certification – Secondary/SPED



The 2020 - 2024, Alternative Routes MAE with Secondary and Special Education Certification

- The certificate portion is 19 semester hours from summer 2020 to spring 2021, plus 18 credits of Continuing Education coursework for the special education endorsement.
- After completion of the certificate portion, students have 3 years to complete the remaining 17 credits required of the MAE degree.

The option to complete a thesis for pass/fail credit will add 4 additional credits to the degree at a cost of \$867 per credit.

Tuition is based on a cohort model. Students must complete the program with their cohort to remain eligible for cohort pricing. Tuition for 500 Level coursework is \$867 per credit. Tuition for 900 Level coursework is \$250 per credit.

Additional fees include: technology fee (\$250/year), wellness fee (\$100/year), a one-time matriculation fee (\$200), books and materials for coursework, certification, fingerprinting, testing, etc.

**Total tuition for certification program with special education coursework (37 credits): \$20,973**

**Total tuition w/MAE (54 credits): \$35,712**
