## Program Cost Sheet 2022-2023 Master of Arts in Education Alternate Route to Secondary Certification



The MAE Alternative Routes with Secondary Certification requires 34 semester credits for completion. Students can choose to complete both the certification and the degree requirements, or complete the certification portion only.

- The certification portion is 23 semester hours from summer 2022 to spring 2023.
- The remaining 11 credits for the MAE degree can be completed within 3 years (by spring 2025).

Tuition is based on a cohort model. Students must complete the program with their cohort to remain eligible for cohort pricing.

Total program tuition for certification (23 credits): \$20,700 (\$900 per credit)

Total program tuition for certification plus MAE (34 credits): \$30,600 (\$900 per credit)

English Language Learners and Special Education endorsement options represent an additional tuition cost.

Additional fees include: technology fee (\$250/year), wellness fee (\$100/year), a one-time matriculation fee (\$200), books and materials for coursework, certification, fingerprinting, etc.
