

Program Cost Sheet 2022-2023

Master of Arts in Education with Secondary Certification



The one-year MAE with Secondary Certification program requires 36 semester credits for completion, starting from summer of 2022 to spring 2023.

For students starting the program in Summer 2022, the total program cost is \$32,400. Tuition is based on a cohort model. Students must complete the program with their cohort to remain eligible for cohort pricing.

Total program tuition: \$32,400 or \$900 per semester hour

Additional fees include: technology fee (\$250/year), wellness fee (\$100/year), a one-time matriculation fee (\$200), books and materials for coursework, certification, fingerprinting, etc.
