

The one-year MAE with Secondary Certification program requires 36 semester credits for completion, starting from summer of 2023 to spring 2024.

Tuition is based on a cohort model. Students must complete the program with their cohort to remain eligible for cohort pricing.

Total program tuition: \$33,480 or \$930 per semester hour

Additional fees include: technology fee (\$260/year), wellness fee (\$110/year), a one-time matriculation fee (\$205), books and materials for coursework, certification, fingerprinting, etc.
