What's New With Tacoma MESA?

Tacoma MESA has been adjusting to Covid-19 and creative as to how we will deliver our program and services to our students during this time. Since September, we have had a new director Penda Samba join our team. This year we have 17 amazing MESA teachers and are in 14 schools across the Tacoma area. We have also been rewarded a grant for **\$14,000** from the Washington Youth Development Nonprofit Relief Fund. This fund was created in response to Covid-19 forcing schools to move to remote learning. These funds will be used to purchase at home science kits, iPads, and help provide tutoring services.
