Program Cost Sheet MA in Marriage and Family Therapy



- The 2015-2017, 24-month Marriage and Family Program is 47 continuous semester hours from fall of 2015 to summer or fall of 2017, with a total program cost of \$48,645 or \$1,035 per semester hour.
- Students may choose to do a five practica/theory sequence for an additional 2 semester units. The program length increases to 27-months, with 49 continuous semester hours for a total program cost of \$50,715.
- Tuition is based on a cohort model. Students must complete the program with their cohort to remain eligible for cohort pricing.
- Additional fees may include: Books, Graduation Fee, etc.
- Federal financial aid is available, and students may apply for PLU Graduate scholarship and fellowships. The FAFSA application becomes available for the following academic year on January 1st.
